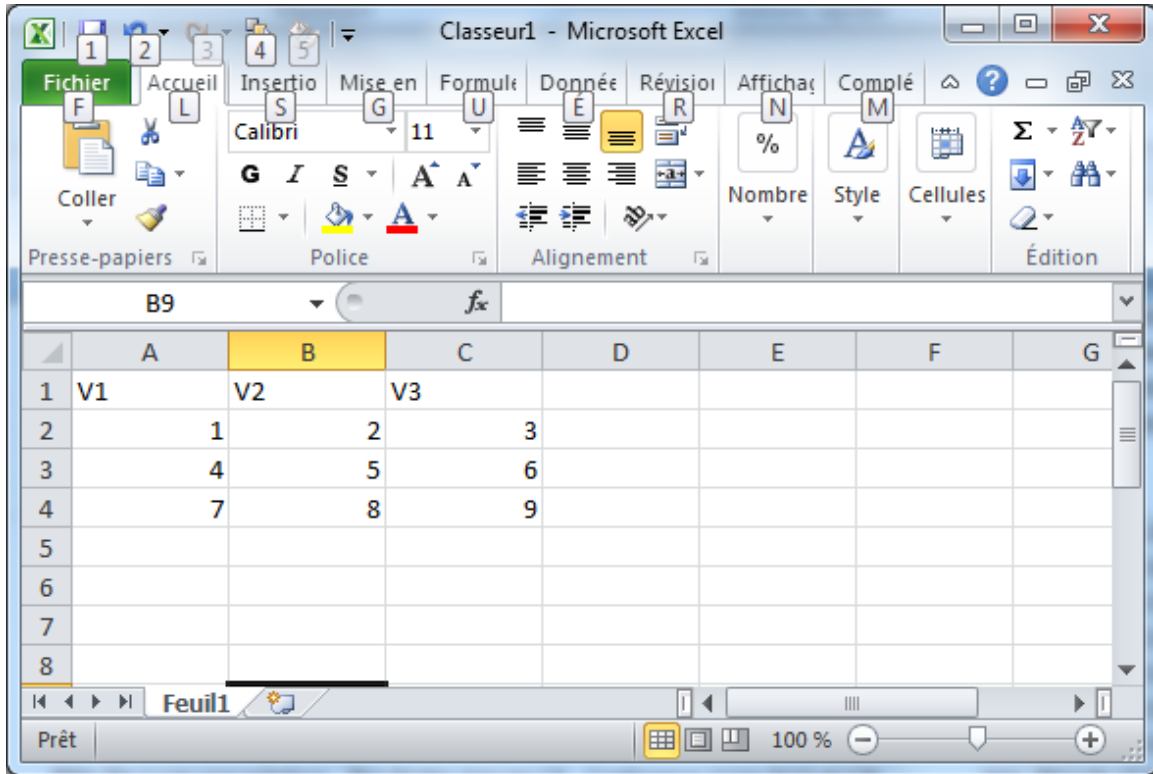


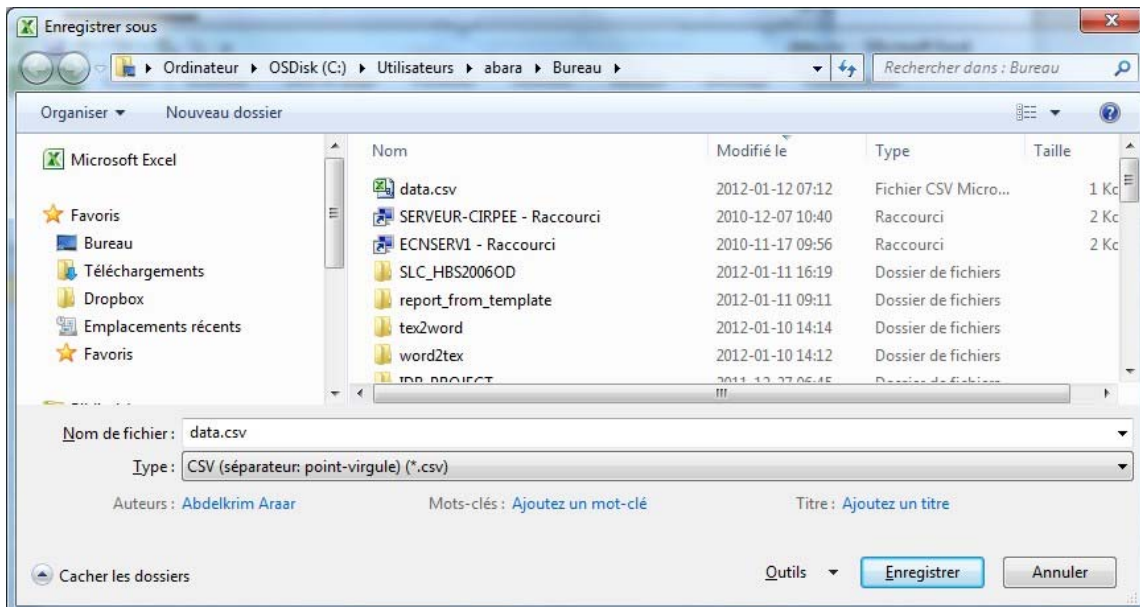
STEP A

We have an Excel file. At this stage, be sure that you do not have any omitted value:



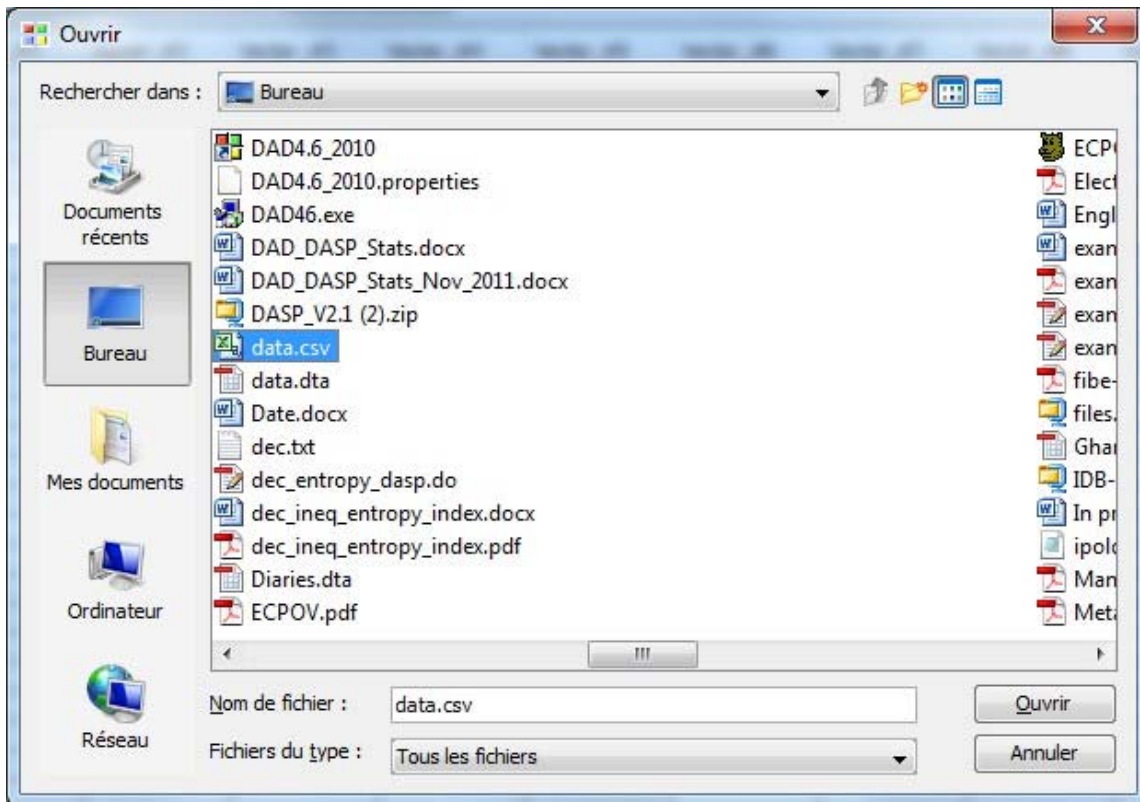
STEP B

STEP C

Open the *.csv file with DAD (type of file (all files)).
